In all cases, the electrical in-feed set-up from a workstation to your building's power source must be conducted by a qualified electrician. Contracting with a local qualified electrician for any reason above is the responsibility of the buyer. Neither OfficeMax or its vendors or suppliers accept liability when a buyer elects to complete electrical connections outside the involvement of qualified personnel.
